Christmas Billboard. Use your railing balusters as a framework to spell out a holiday greeting – secure light strands with zip ties to spell out letters. Balusters also work extremely well to secure wreaths, large red and white candy canes and other large lighted décor.

Yard Décor - now Deck Décor. If your living or family room looks out onto the deck, try placing white wire-frame deer on the deck instead of out in the yard. For basement rooms that open out to under the deck, hang a lit Moravian Star or even mistletoe from a joist to add an unexpected festive element.

Scents of the Season. If visitors will be entering your home from the deck, add an additional burst of seasonal welcome by incorporating cinnamon sticks and real pine greenery into your decorations.
